

Purposeful Life Scholarship Fund Program Guidelines

Cultured Pearl is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization geared to support women of God by providing them with the tools according to scripture to bring them into God's light. Often, we go to worship to get the scripture and the word but sometimes we have to see it put to work in order to get that beacon of light that God is trying to send to us.

Our Mission is to supply women of God with scriptures and tools to support real life scenarios and challenges that they face every day.

Our Vision is to reach women of every culture so that they may show other women God's power and light.

We provide tools via conferences, seminars. We provide scholarships and recognition awards.

For 2024, the Purposeful Life Scholarship will award scholarships to a high school senior or seniors each year in the amount designated by the scholarship funds. Purposeful Life scholarship awards are designated as tuition only and will be paid directly to the recipient's school of choice upon verification of acceptance **NOTE: Scholarship funds will be** awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited higher educational institution.

Criteria and eligibility

The goal is to award a qualified applicant, not to have to choose according to their "merit" but how they are a positive influence on others in their Christian Life.

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
 Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (or a "C" average).
- 3. Applicant must demonstrate community involvement, improvement in academics, and desires to attend college.
- 4. All applicants must have 50 hours of community service.
- 5. Applicants may not be related to any Board of Directors or staff for this presents a conflict of interest.
- 6. Applicants must be willing to attend a scholarship an interview with the Executive Committee of Cultured Pearl via zoom
- 7. Applicants must be willing to attend the annual fundraiser event or Scholarship Brunch
- 8. Respond in a timely manner of 24-48 hours if selected as a recipient of the scholarship. Responding in an untimely manner will cause automatic forfeit of your scholarship.

General Instructions

- 1. DEADLINE for scholarship applications is April 15, 2024, 11:59 p.m. (no exceptions).
- 2. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. If any question does not apply to you in this application, please put N/A in the space.

- 4. Type and print legibly. Illegible applications will not be considered. You may also download a copy of the application online at www.culturedpearl.org

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation about yourself and your college plans (college/university, intended major, and anticipated start date). Letter should not exceed one (1) page.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individual with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/rank.
- 5. Personal Essay which explains how your spiritual Christian experience has influenced your life. Essay must be at least 1-2 typed pages, double-spaced, 12 pt / Time New Roman font. Essay shall contain no grammatical errors.
- 6. In addition to the above items, applicant must also complete at least 50 hours of community service. Community service hours must be documented in the form of a letter.
- 7. All requirements must be emailed no exceptions.

Deadline for the application is **April 15, 2024, 11:59 p.m.** Applications or any requirements emailed after this date will not be considered.

Once the recipient has received the scholarship, a letter should be sent to the recipient's high school so that the information can be included in that school's list of scholarships received. Acknowledgement of the recipients will be made during the annual fundraiser event or seminar. The recipient must attend the annual awards and fundraiser event to receive the award. It is the responsibility of the recipient to inform Cultured Pearl of which institution he/she plans to attend if he/she is awarded the Purposeful Life Scholarship.
